Waste Disposal Rates

for

**Automated Tipplers, Electric Dumpers, Small vehicles (*Less than 15,000 lbs*)
and vehicles unloading by hand**

Domestic Waste \$5.00 per cubic yard

- All perishable refuse (kitchen garbage)
- Household rubbish
- Rags
- Bottles, cans
- Waste from small businesses (less than 100 gallons per week)
- Bicycles, lawnmowers, etc

Commercial Waste \$5.00 per cubic yard

- All waste from businesses (except those generating less than 100 gallons per week whose waste is picked up with domestic waste by their hauler)
- White goods from businesses and haulers

Construction / Demolition \$5 light or 15.00 per cubic yard if it is dense

- Shingles, sheetrock, dirt & railroad ties.
- Bagged Yard Waste
- All acceptable waste listed on page 3

Electronic Waste

- Intact e-waste \$ 400 per ton
- Harvested CRT TV's & Monitors \$ 500 per ton
- Crushed CRT TV's & Monitors \$1,000 per ton

Yard / Brush Waste \$5.00 per cubic yard

Loose Leaves, Grass Clippings, Tree/Branch trimmings under 6" in diameter, less than 6' long.

Note: Yard / Brush Waste exceeding 6" in diameter, more than 6' long and containing bags or other contaminants will be classified as Construction/Demolition Waste.

Domestic Waste \$20.00 per ton

All perishable refuse (kitchen garbage)

Waste from small businesses (less than 100 gallons per week)

Commercial Waste \$33.00 per ton

All waste from businesses (except those generating less than 100 gallons per week whose waste is picked up with domestic waste by their hauler)
White goods from businesses and haulers

Industrial / Special Waste \$33.00

All Generators/Haulers should request approval for the disposal of their special waste in writing and will be notified of acceptance or advised of procedures should an inspection or any testing be required prior to disposal.

All waste from industries
Pre-compressed and high-density materials
Dusts
Bailed Goods, Plastic Rolls, Steel/Plastic Banding
Textile Waste
Waste requiring inspection and approval prior to disposal
Steel/plastic banding

Special Handling Waste \$75.00 per ton

Any waste which causes equipment problems during disposal

Mulch Program

Twin Chimneys Landfill will load mulch into vehicles for citizens of Greenville County on Thursday, Friday & Saturday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. & 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.
The landfill staff is unavailable to load mulch at any other times.

1/2 scoop is a free loading charge free and there is a \$15.00 loading fee for each additional scoop.
Bulk rate is \$16.50 per ton loading fee.

Unacceptable Waste

Any waste that has been in contact with petroleum products
Any waste that has been in contact with friable asbestos materials

Controlled Materials

Lead Acid Batteries
Waste Oil
Yard/Brush and Cellulosic waste
White Goods
Tires
E-Waste

Anyone depositing a waste load at a Greenville County Solid Waste Facility without first separating those controlled materials listed above shall be assessed an additional fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per ton.
