Equipment: A personal laptop computer will be provided to aid in the prosecution of DUI cases by: allowing instant access to discovery materials to include SLED and Incident-Site videos, law enforcement reports, accessing the Westlaw legal research database and the South Carolina Code of Laws. The laptop will also aid in pretrial conference negotiations by allowing instant playback of the incident site video to demonstrate the strength of the State's case to the defendant or the defense attorney as all road-side video is uploaded to our office servers beforehand. Such a tool can be instrumental in resolving cases via guilty pleas at the pretrial stage and avoiding 	

the need for jury trials entirely.
