- a. **General Description:** Working in partnership with the Greenville Textile Heritage Society, the Greenville County Recreation District will develop a 6.3 acre passive park next to Monaghan Mill. This park will use interpretive signage to highlight Greenville's rich textile heritage while offering visitors and residents a beautiful passive park complete with a walking trail, shelter, playground, and small stage.
- b. Benefit project will provide the Community: The benefits to this project are twofold. First, this park will serve as a tourist destination for visitors interested in learning more about Greenville's textile heritage. Second, this park will further the redevelopment of the Monahan Mill area benefiting existing families and drawing in new families.
