This refers to your request for an estimate for a water main extension to serve the above-referenced property.


According to our measurements, a water main could be extended 710 feet along Plum Branch Road to serve the property. Our extension policy requires that the requesting party finance a portion of the project cost at \$20.00 per foot under our standard Reimbursement Agreement. Accordingly, your portion of the project cost would be 710 feet at \$20.00 per foot for a total of \$14,200.00.

In addition to the cost of the main extension, the requesting party must pay standard connection fees to the Greenville Water System (see attached "Schedule of Fees and Charges" and "Notice to Our Customers") and all applicable plumbers' fees.

APPLICATION FOR COUNCIL GRANT ASSISTANCE WITH LIFE SAFETY WATER LINE INSTALLATION

Applications will be based on health and life safety issues that include contaminated/non-potable wells, dry wells and fire protection. Greenville County Public Works Department, Engineering Division, will take applications for Council Grant Assistance with Life Safety Water Line Installation. Applications will be reviewed and scored by the Facilities Project Manager, Assistant County Administrator for Public Works, and the Engineering Division for completeness and criteria and will be submitted to Public Works, Planning and Development Committee for consideration on a first come, first serve basis.

This is a 50/50 grant program; therefore, the County of Greenville, upon approval by County Council, will provide 50% and the applicant will provide the other 50% for the installation of the water main and/or fire hydrant down the public road. The applicant has 60 days to secure their portion of the funding and remit to the County of Greenville. The respective property owners are responsible for the tap/meter fee and connection to the dwelling.

I checked the well at 140 Plum Branch Drive Pelzer, SC 29669 and for general household use; I would consider it dry. The water is so low the pump would not stay primed for more than a few minutes. I then went to 130 Plum Branch Drive. The property at 130 Plum Branch Drive does not have an existing well. It is attached to the well at 140 Plum Branch Drive. I then went to 120 Plum Branch Drive and the property does not have an existing well on it either. It is attached to a neighbor's well that supports several families and is by all accounts going dry itself. I did not check this well because the neighbor was not home to give permission. I did check the water pressure and it was low and erratic.
