General Description: Renovate and upgrade the restrooms and kitchen; new a. pipes, fixtures, cabinets, and sinks

b. Benefit project will provide the Community: As one of the oldest GCRD facilities, there have been consistent issues with the plumbing and use of the restrooms and kitchen area. With older pipes, they retain water and there can be a "stench" until maintenance repairs them. Because of the old fixtures, GCRD continues to spend funding on this project regularly to "band-aid" the problems. This has not been a good investment. With new fixtures and piping, the facility will provide more comfort to the residents of the community and they will be more apt to use the facility and feel proud of this resource in their neighborhood.

Additional Comments: Just Kids, Inc. operates a daily afterschool and summer C. camp program in the facility. They average 25 students during the school year and 50 during the summer. The Neighborhood Association also regularly meets at the facility with an average attendance of 15-20 residents.
