APPLICATION FOR COUNCIL GRANT ASSISTANCE WITH LIFE SAFETY WATER LINE INSTALLATION

Applications will be based on health and life safety issues that include contaminated/non-potable wells, dry wells and fire protection. Greenville County Public Works Department, Engineering Division, will take applications for Council Grant Assistance with Life Safety Water Line Installation. Applications will be reviewed and scored by the Facilities Project Manager, Assistant County Administrator for Public Works, and the Engineering Division for completeness and criteria and will be submitted to Public Works, Planning and Development Committee for consideration on a first come, first serve basis.

This is a 50/50 grant program; therefore, the County of Greenville, upon approval by County Council, will provide 50% and the applicant will provide the other 50% for the installation of the water main and/or fire hydrant down the public road. The applicant has 60 days to secure their portion of the funding and remit to the County of Greenville. The respective property owners are responsible for the tap/meter fee and connection to the dwelling.

Dear Mrs. Wilson and Chief Merritt:

This refers to your request for an estimate for a water main extension to serve the referenced properties.

According to our measurements, a water main could be extended 4,400 feet along E. Georgia Road to serve the Wilson property. An additional 776 feet is required to serve the fire station. Our extension policy requires that the requesting party finance a portion of the project cost at \$20.00 per foot under our standard Reimbursement Agreement. Accordingly, your portion of the project cost would be 4,400 feet at \$20.00 per foot for a total of \$88,000.00. The portion of the project cost to serve the fire station would be an additional 776 feet at \$20.00 per foot for an additional cost of \$15,520.00.

In addition to the cost of the main extension, the requesting party must pay standard connection fees to Greenville Water and all applicable plumbers' fees.

Please contact us at your earliest convenience if you would like to proceed with this project.

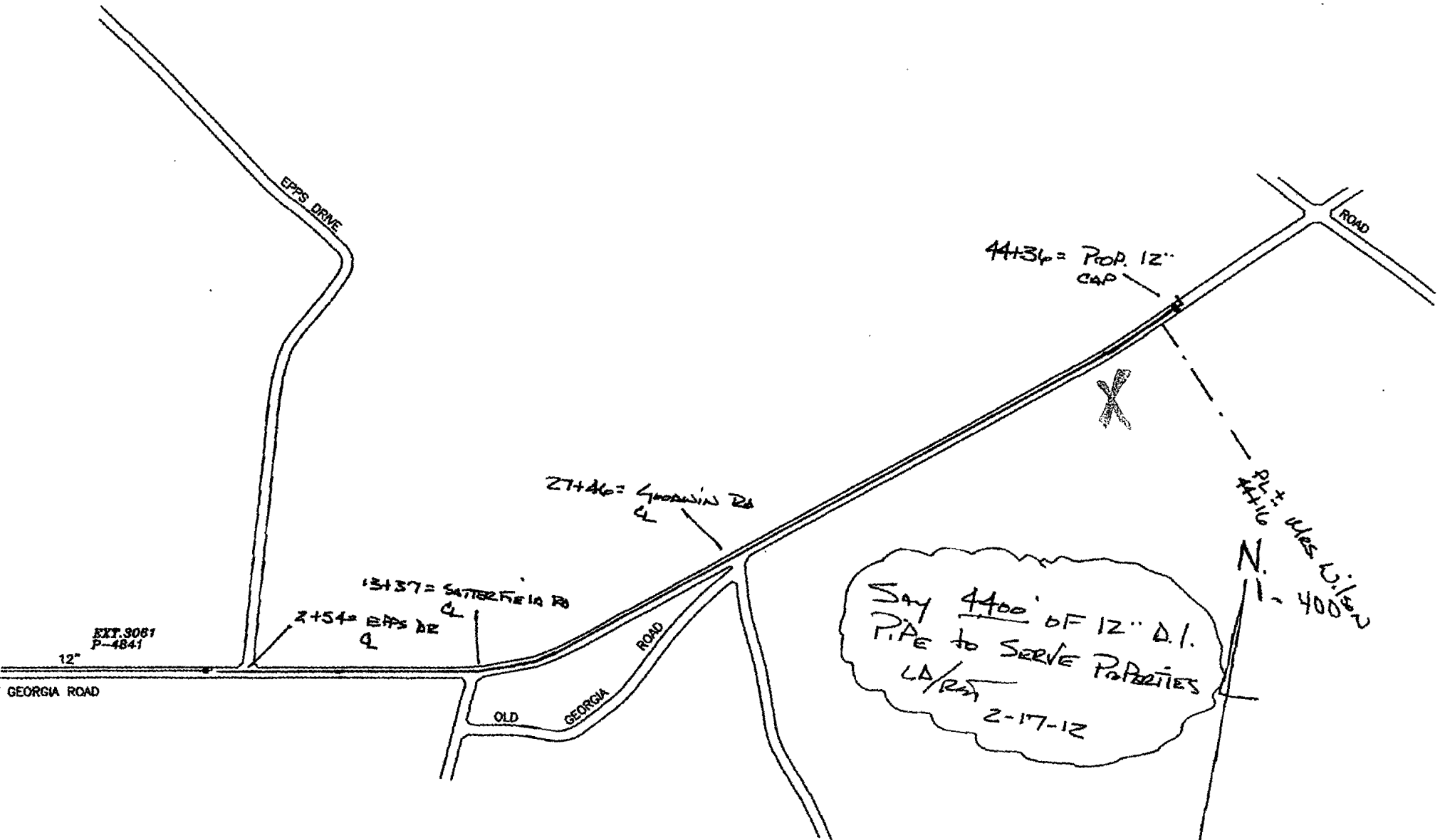

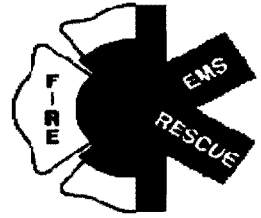

RE: Policy for Council Grant Assistance with Life Safety Water Line Installation
The Wilsons and Clear Spring Fire - Rescue, 2400 Block East Georgia Road

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is written in reference to item #3 of the procedures section as outlined in the *Policy for Council Grant Assistance with Life Safety Water Line Installation*, as it relates to the 2400 block of East Georgia Road, Simpsonville, SC. The properties in discussion are as follows; 2436 East Georgia Road, tax map number 0555010100200, owned by Chad and Jennifer Wilson and 2435 East Georgia Road, tax map number 0554020100203, owned by Clear Spring Fire - Rescue (East Simpsonville Fire Department), both are seeking assistance with the installation of a municipal waterline through a joint application.

In regards to item #3, currently there are no municipal waterlines in this section of East Georgia Road, thus meaning no fire hydrants; the closest fire hydrants that are available are located near the intersection of East Georgia Road and Coachman Drive, which is approximately 1.6 miles and another located near the intersection of East Georgia Road and Epps Drive which is approximately .9 miles.

This being stated, there is definitely a fire safety issue / concern in this 2.5 mile section of East Georgia Road; our engines carry 1,200 feet of 5" supply line, and a typical response dictates 2 engines respond to a structure fire, thus forcing us to operate a water shuttle.

Due to not having municipal water lines and fire hydrants in this area, I cannot recommend any line upgrades, only line installation. Additionally, I can only provide a statement as to the average water pressures in our service area; I can safely say that the majority of fire hydrants in our service area operate at a minimum of 1,000 gallons per minute (gpm).
