Proposed Amendments from Councilor Meadows

Section I Officers Of The Council

(A) Chairman

At its initial meeting in January following each general election, the Council, as specified by law, shall elect one of its members to serve as Chairman for a term of two years. The Chairman may serve only two consecutive terms. After not serving as Chairman for one year one will be eligible to serve as Chairman again for another two consecutive terms.

(B) Vice-Chairman

At its initial meeting in January following each general election, the Council, as specified by law, shall elect one of its members to serve as Vice-Chairman for a term of two years. The Vice Chairman may serve only two consecutive terms. After not serving as Vice Chairman for one year one will be eligible to serve as Vice Chairman again for another two consecutive terms.

Delete present verbiage and replace with the following

No Council member, no family member of a Council member, and no business with which a council member is associated Shall have an economic interest in a contract with Greenville County for the sale or lease of land, materials, supplies, equipment, or service, nor shall currently elect to receive services from any entity governed by County Council.

For purposes of this rule, the phrase ELECT TO RECEIVE SERVICES shall not include compliance with a governmental regulation or mandate. Violation of this section with the express or implied knowledge of the Council member, family member, or business with which the Council member is associated shall render the contract or sale void.

(12) Parliamentary Procedure not specified in these Rules--In all particulars not specifically set forth in these rules or by Acts of the South Carolina General Assembly describing rules or procedures to be guided by the County Council, the presiding officer shall be guided by the most recent edition of

Roberts Rules of Order.
