PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY

in Greenville County

WHEREAS, Americans should always remember the December 7, 1941 military attacks on the United States by the Japanese Empire at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, more than 2,400 U.S. Military personnel were killed in the sneak attack; and

WHEREAS, the dead and wounded included citizens of Greenville County, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, their service and sacrifice should be remembered and recognized on the "date that will live in infamy";

NOW, THEREFORE, Greenville County Council herby proclaims Saturday, December 7, 2013 as "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day" to be observed by a daylight display of the United States flag at half-mast throughout Greenville County.
