

**AN ORDINANCE**

**TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE TO THE MILLAGE RATE LEVIED BY THE FOOTHILLS FIRE SERVICE AREA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Foothills Fire Service Area is serviced under agreement by the Tryon Fire Department and the Landrum Fire Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Foothills Fire Service Area Board of Fire Control has presented a budget and millage request to Greenville County Council providing for expenditures of revenues acquired by the Foothills Fire Service Area pursuant to ad valorem property taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Foothills Fire Service Area is authorized by Ordinance No. 2268 to annually levy ad valorem property tax millage for operations and maintenance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Foothills Fire Service Area Board of Fire Control has requested an increase to the Fire Service Area’s current millage rate for continued operations and maintenance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:**

**Section 1. Millage Rate and Tax Levy.** Greenville County Council hereby approves an increase of three-tenths (0.3) mill, which represents CPI and Growth as allowed under S.C. Code Ann. §§ 6-1-320(A), bringing the total millage for operations and maintenance to ten and eight-tenths (10.8) mills for the Foothills Fire Service Area, as requested.

The Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect taxes in accordance with this Ordinance.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
