Greenville County is applying for an ARC grant in the amount of \$500,000 for the Hampton Avenue Extension Pedestrian Bridge Project. The project is roughly estimated at \$1,350,000 (see attached). The bridge will be approximately 175 feet long, crossing several active Norfolk Southern railroad lines. The County is pursuing multiple funding sources to fully fund this project. Currently we have secured \$500,000 from Greenville Legislative Delegation Transportation Committee (GLDTC/C-Funds).
