APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilor Kirven moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of November 11, 2013. The motion carried unanimously.

GRANT APPLICATION:

SC PARK AND RECREATION DEVELOPMENT:

This is the SC Park and Recreation Development Fund Grant in the amount of \$26,221.25. The State share is \$20,977.00 and the Local Share is \$5,244.25 which will come from Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Department budget. The grant will allow the Parks, Recreation and Tourism Department to construct a new storage building, make kitchen renovations to bring up to DHEC standards at the Mt. Pleasant Community Center. This grant does not require a County match.

Ruth Parris, Budget Manager and Gene Smith, Parks, Recreation, and Tourism were present to answer questions of the committee.

Councilor Burns moved to approve the SC Park and Recreation Development Fund Grant in the amount \$26,221.25. The motion carried unanimously.

COMMUNITY PROJECT APPLICATION:

This is a Community Project Application from the City of Travelers Rest in the amount of \$1,800. The funds will be used to help defray the Christmas parade expenses.

John Hansley, Deputy County Administrator was present to answer questions of the committee.

Councilor Burns moved to approve the Community Project Application from the City of Travelers Rest in the amount of \$1,800 for Christmas parade expenses. The funds for the project will be split between Chairman Meadows and Councilor Dill. The motion carried unanimously.

PRECISION VALVE CORPORATION/AMENDMENT TO INDUCEMENT AGREEMENT:

Councilor Kirven moved to approve the resolution authorizing the execution and delivery of a First Amendment to the Inducement and Millage Rate Agreement between Greenville County and Precision Valve Corporation. The motion carried unanimously.
