NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Greenville County Council, will conduct a public hearing on the proposed adoption of an Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT EXCEEDING TWO MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,400,000) GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING AND IMPROVEMENT BONDS (GLASSY MOUNTAIN FIRE SERVICE AREA PROJECT), SERIES 2015A; TO PRESCRIBE THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE PROCEEDS SHALL BE EXPENDED; TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO" on June 2, 2015 in the Chambers of County Council, County Square, 301 University Ridge, Greenville, South Carolina 29601, at 6:00 p.m. The above-referenced Bonds will be used to (i) refund all or a portion of (a) the \$2,100,000 original principal amount General Obligation Bond (Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area Project), Series 2005 and (b) the \$980,000 original principal amount General Obligation Bond (Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area Project), Series 2009 and (ii) defray the costs of the acquisition of (a) thermal imaging equipment, (b) rescue fire trucks, (c) engine fire trucks, and (d) various other items of equipment for the Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area, a special tax district created by the County.

For the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bonds authorized by said Ordinance, there shall be pledged the full faith, credit and taxing power of the County and there shall be initially levied ad valorem taxes solely within the Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area sufficient in amount to pay said principal and interest on the Bonds.

At the time and place fixed for said public hearing all taxpayers, residents or other interested persons who appear will be given an opportunity to express their views for or against the adoption of the Ordinance.
