

AN ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED BY THE TIGERVILLE FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Tigerville Fire District Board of Fire Control has presented a budget and millage request to Greenville County Council providing for expenditures of revenues acquired by the Tigerville Fire District pursuant to ad valorem property taxes;

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Council, in accordance with Section 4-9-140 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended, desires to adopt the Board of Fire Control’s recommendation for the Tigerville Fire District’s millage request; and

WHEREAS, the Tigerville Fire District is authorized by ordinance to annually levy, for operations and maintenance, ad valorem property tax millage, and the Boards of Fire Control has requested an increase to the District’s current millage levy, which request is subject to the millage rate increase limitations in S.C. Code Ann. § 6-1-320.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Millage and Tax Levy. Greenville County Council hereby approves an ad valorem property tax increase of eight-tenths (0.8) mill bringing the total millage for operations and maintenance to twenty-three and six-tenths (23.6) mills for the Tigerville Fire District, which represents a consumer price index of 1.62% and population growth of 1.8% as allowed by the State law under S.C. Code Ann. § 6-1-320(A). The ad valorem property tax millage increase set forth herein is based on 2014-2015 millage rates and is subject to reassessment year calculations pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 12-37-251(E). The Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect the millage rates authorized by this Ordinance.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
