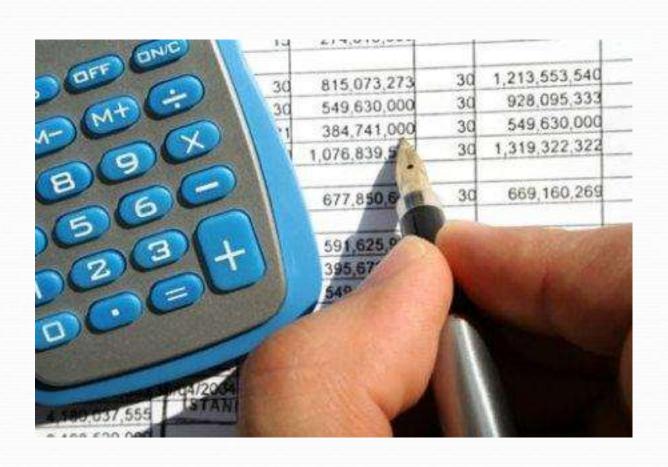

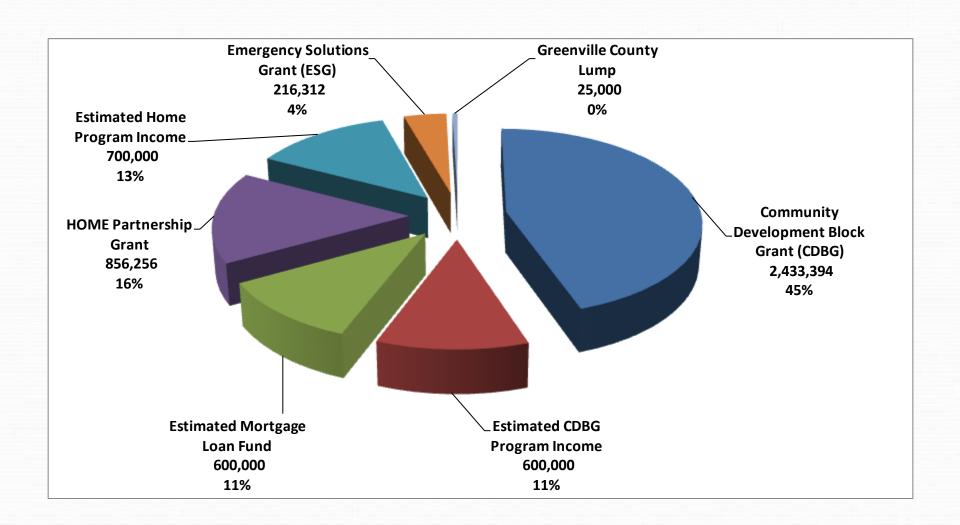
FY 2016 Annual Action Plan

- This funding period also marks the 2nd year allocation of funds and activities for the current Greenville County's 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan

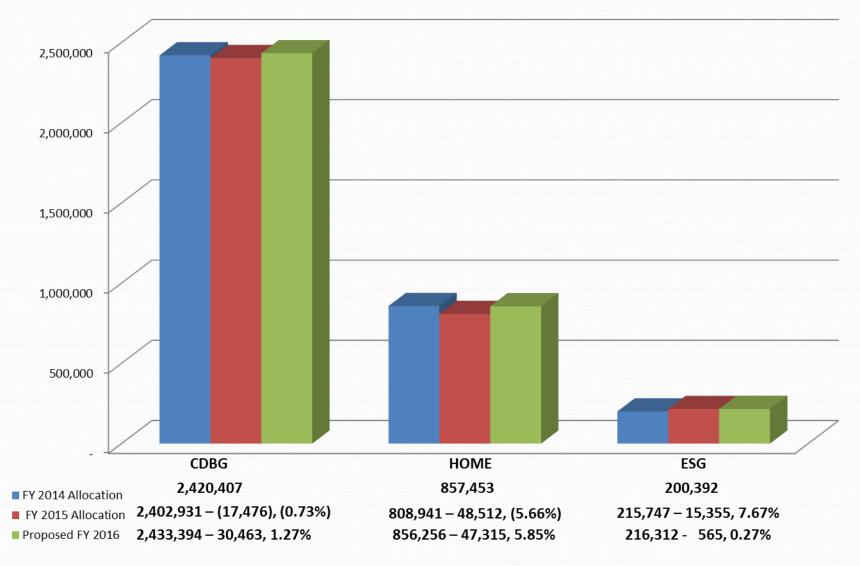
FY 2016 ESTIMATED BUDGET



Greenville County Redevelopment Authority 2016 AAP Budget Breakout by Source FY 2016 Total estimated budget: \$5,430,961

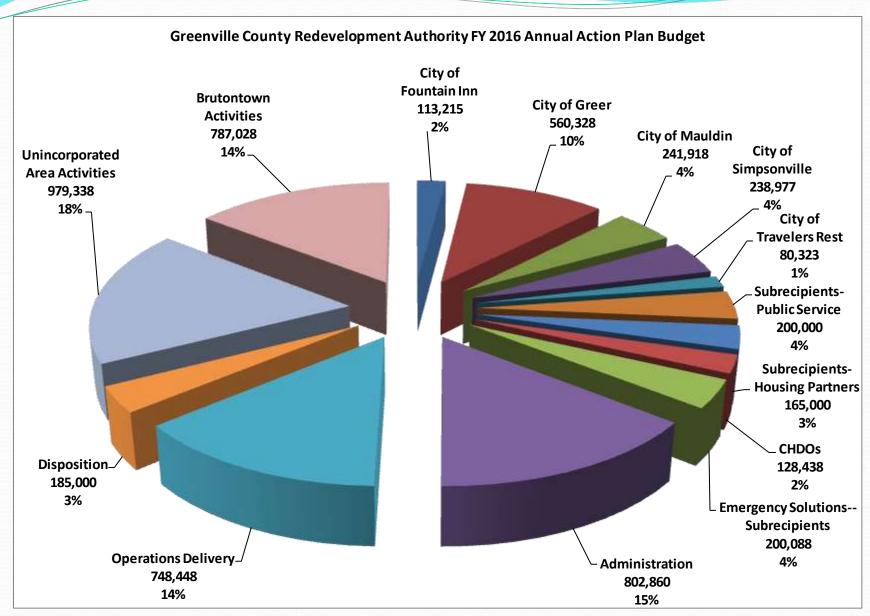


Greenville County Redevelopment Authority 3 year AAP Core Fund Grant Budget Comparison

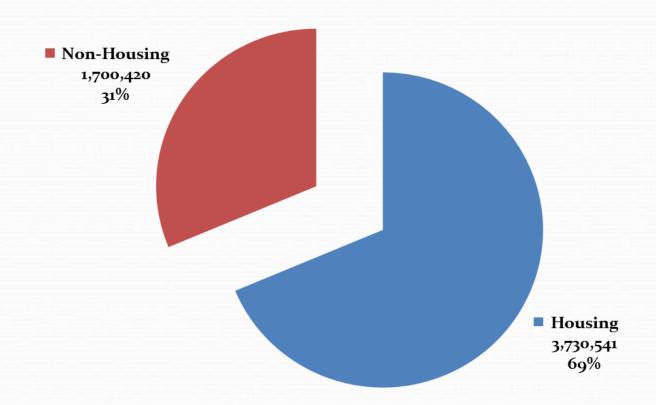

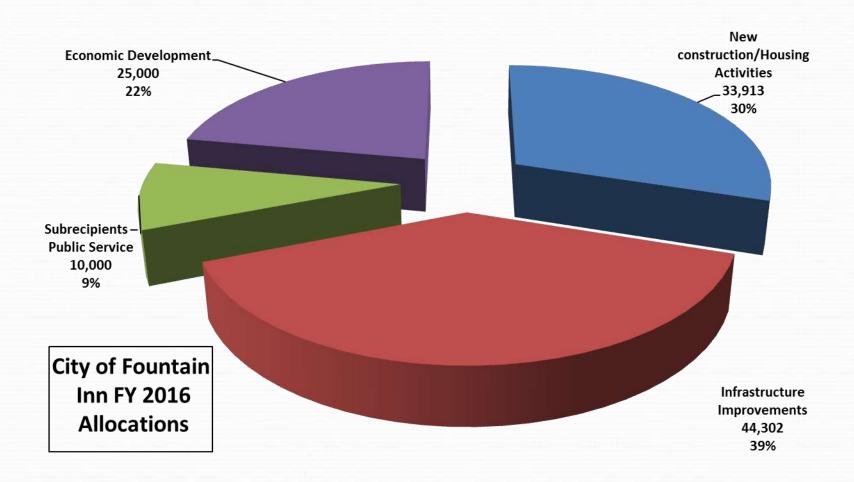
Greenville County Redevelopment Authority FY 2016 Housing vs Non-Housing Comparison

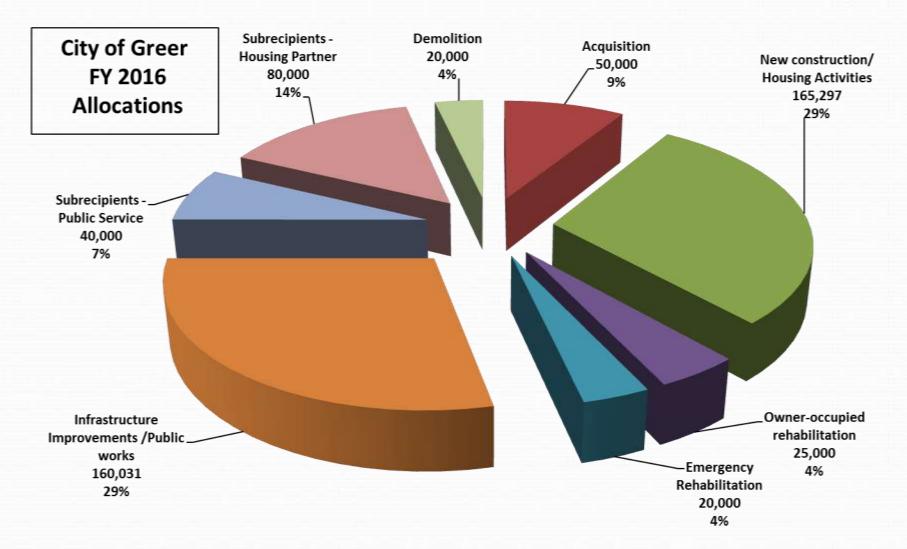

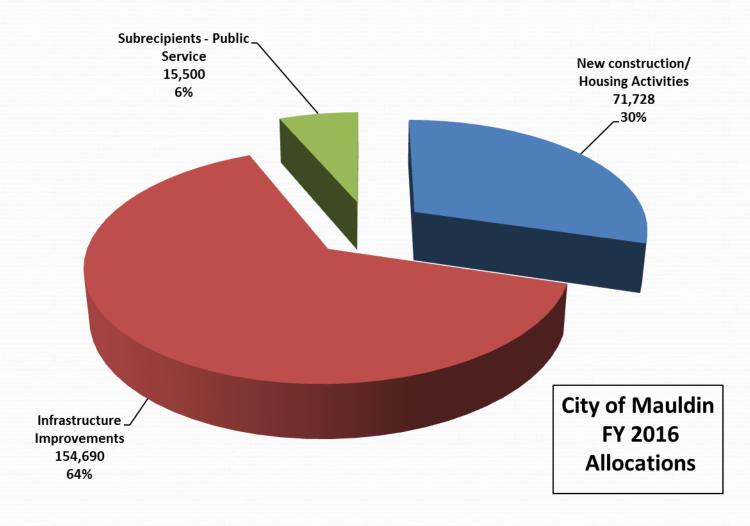
