COUNCIL COMMUNITY PROJECT ACCOUNT POLICY

Proposed Amendment --

Amend the Council Community Project Account Policy to add the following eligible expenditures shown as underlined:

Community Project Account appropriations will continue to fund only small, de minimus public projects associated with special, non-recurring requests for infrastructure purposes such as: public buildings and grounds; community centers open to the residents of Greenville County; infrastructure related studies; flooding; roads; lights; sewer and drainage; to fund contractual agreements for social, recreational, and educational programs/services; and contributions to taxing entities providing services in Greenville County for non-recurring local projects. Community Project Account appropriations will continue to fund only small, de minimus public projects associated with special, non-recurring requests for infrastructure purposes such as: public buildings and grounds; infrastructure related studies; flooding; roads; lights; sewer and drainage; and contributions to taxing entities providing services in Greenville County for local projects. County Council members will serve as sponsors for any Community Project Account applications submitted. Project applications will be required to go to Finance Committee for review and be approved by County Council. Council Members, at their discretion, may transfer into their Community Project Account any unspent Council District Expense funds not required for business expenses used in the discharge of their public duties.

<u>Note</u> – The purpose of the amendment is to expand the Policy to allow Council to approve grants to assist with community center building maintenance, and social, recreational, and educational programs/services that benefit neighborhoods and neighborhood children.
