Item Title: Boiling Springs Fire District

Action Taken by Committee previously: The Finance Committee last approved a millage increase for the Boiling Springs Fire District in 2013 – Resolution 1482

Motion Requested Today: Boiling Springs Fire District requests adoption of a Resolution approving (a) a five-tenths (0.5) mill increase in the District's tax rate which represents CPI and population growth of 2.04% for tax year 2016 as allowed per Section 6-1-320A of the South Carolina Code of Laws, and (b) an increase in the District's tax rate of one and five-tenths (1.5) mills which represents the lookback CPI and population growth for tax years 2014 and 2015 as allowed per Section 6-1-320A of the South Carolina Code of Laws for a total increase of two and zero-tenths (2.0) mills.

Staff Recommendation: N/A

Impact of Action: A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$200,000 would pay an additional \$16.00 annually due to this millage increase for operations.
