

A RESOLUTION

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A BOND REFERENDUM CONDUCTED IN THE BOILING SPRINGS FIRE DISTRICT, SOUTH CAROLINA ON JANUARY 10, 2017.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an ordinance enacted by the County Council of Greenville County (the “*County Council*”), the governing body of Greenville County, South Carolina (the “*County*”), dated September 20, 2016, the Council ordered that a bond referendum be held in the Boiling Springs Fire District (the “*District*”) on the question of the issuance of not exceeding \$2,100,000 of general obligation bonds of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Board of Voter Registration and Elections (the “*Board*”) conducted a Bond Referendum in the District on January 10, 2017 (the “*Referendum*”) where the following question (the “*Question*”) was submitted to the qualified voters of the District:

Shall the Boiling Springs Fire District, located in Greenville County, South Carolina (the “*District*”), be authorized to issue and sell, either as a single issue or as several separate issues, general obligation bonds of the District in an aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$2,100,000, the proceeds of which shall be applied to defray the costs, along with legal and related expenses, of the following: (i) acquiring and equipping fire apparatuses; (ii) payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds as they respectively mature; and (iii) creation of a sinking fund as may be necessary therefor.

WHEREAS, the Board has certified to the Council that the result of the Referendum was in favor of the Question.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL IN A MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED that the Council hereby declares that the result of the Referendum was in favor of the Question, there having been 42 votes cast in favor of the Question and 6 votes cast in opposition to the Question. A copy of the results, as certified by the Board, is attached hereto as Exhibit A. A certified copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Clerk of Court for Greenville County and maintained in the records thereof.
