Staff Report	<p>ANALYSIS: The subject site is zoned R-R3, and is within the Agricultural (10 acre minimum) area of the <u>South Greenville Area Plan</u>. R-R3 is the largest lot zone that the County currently has.</p> <p>SUMMARY: The subject parcel zoned R-R3, Rural Residential, is 1.8 acres of property located on Reedy Fork Road approximately 1.3 miles northeast of the intersection of Reedy Fork Road and Highway 418. The parcel has approximately 280 feet of frontage along Slatton Shoals Road. The applicant is requesting to rezone the property to R-R1, Rural Residential.</p> <p>The applicant states the proposed land use is for residential.</p> <p>CONCLUSION: The applicant is requesting to rezone to R-R1, Rural Residential. The parcel is surrounded by R-R3, Rural Residential to the north, south and west and, with R-R1 zoning to the east. Staff is of the opinion the requested zoning is consistent with the surrounding zoning and land uses in this area and will maintain the rural character. Staff believes rezoning this parcel to R-R1, would have minimal impact to the surrounding area.</p> <p>Based on these reasons staff recommends approval of the requested rezoning to R-R1, Rural Residential.</p>
