

A RESOLUTION

IN SUPPORT OF MIRACLE HILL’S RESCUE MISSION PROGRAMS IMPACTED BY THE PROPOSED LOCATION OF A NEW BREWERY AND RESTAURANT AT 101 S. HUDSON STREET IN GREENVILLE.

WHEREAS, Nautic Greenville, LLC (“Nautic Greenville”) is planning to open a brewery and restaurant selling beer at 101 S. Hudson St. in downtown Greenville; and

WHEREAS, the proposed brewery and restaurant location is next to Miracle Hill’s longstanding Greenville Rescue Mission located at the intersection of S. Hudson and W. Washington Streets; and

WHEREAS, Nautic Greenville’s brewery will be located mere feet from Miracle Hill’s Rescue Mission which can house up to 142 men nightly, with more than 100 additional guests sleeping on the floor of its gym in cold weather, where many of the guests have issues relating to alcohol addiction or are formerly addicted; and

WHEREAS, the Rescue Mission holds a required Chapel program each evening prior to the meal just a few feet away from the proposed brewery, and the Mission attendees regularly gather outside the Mission waiting for Chapel; and

WHEREAS, Nautic Greenville’s decision to place a brewery at this incompatible location will impede Miracle Hill in achieving its mission to assist individuals overcoming addiction and move them toward productive lives.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Greenville County Council believes that Nautic Greenville’s brewery and restaurant next to the Greenville Rescue Mission is not an appropriate location and is insensitive to the background of the men being served at the Mission; and further, County Council recognizes Miracle Hill’s concerns over the conflict presented by placing a brewery and restaurant adjacent to its Rescue Mission, and respectfully requests that Nautic Greenville strongly consider relocating its business away from the Mission property.
