The sculpture will be mounted on a large granite base (5 ft by 4 ft by 3 ft above ground with the inscription "we all need safe places to walk and ride a bike" Bike Walk Greenville 2019 Sculpture by Charles Pate Jr

b. Benefit project will provide the Community:  
to our knowledge is the first bronze sculpture to be donated to Greenville County on the SRT, and it serves a part of our community that has little in public art. Channel Moore is developing a new County process for public art for the County based on this project.

c. Additional Comments: The artist Charles Pate Jr is working with Lakeview Middle School through the principal Latonia Copeland to identify a 3 to 4 year old sibling of a LMS student to be the model for the statue. Additionally, LMS art classes will be visiting the artist's studio on Cedar Lane Road to learn of the process from sketch to clay to bronze.
