

A RESOLUTION

TO ENLARGE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE METROPOLITAN SEWER SUBDISTRICT AND PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC NOTICE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6-11-410, et seq., of the 1976 Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina, as amended (the Act), the governing bodies of the several counties of the State of South Carolina are authorized to enlarge, diminish or consolidate any existing special purpose district located within such counties; and the Greenville County Council is the governing body of Greenville County, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict (“Metropolitan”) is a special purpose district created by Act No. 687 of the 1969 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, as amended by Act No. 1842 of the 1972 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, and as such is a special purpose district created prior to March 7, 1973 to which has been committed the function of acquiring, constructing, operating, maintaining, improving, and extending facilities for the orderly collection of sewage within the boundaries of the Metropolitan and transmission of the same to the trunk and treatment facilities of Renewable Water Resources (formerly known as Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority) for treatment and disposal; and

WHEREAS, a petition has been submitted to Greenville County Council by Metropolitan to enlarge the boundaries of Metropolitan to include the properties described in **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B** attached hereto and incorporated herein (the “Metropolitan Expansion Area”); and

WHEREAS, Greenville County Council finds that the Metropolitan Expansion Area is located wholly within the boundaries of Greenville County, South Carolina, but is not within any special purpose district or municipality which is empowered to construct and maintain sewage collector lateral lines, that annexing such property into Metropolitan would extend the right of Metropolitan to construct and maintain sewage collector lateral lines within the Metropolitan Expansion Area; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the protection of public and environmental health, anticipated planning and economic development of the southern portions of Greenville County, the Greenville County Council has determined that it is in the public interest to expand the boundaries of Metropolitan to include the Metropolitan Expansion Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Greenville County Council that the boundaries of the Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict are hereby enlarged to include the properties described in **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B**, and that pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 6-11-470 (Supp. 2011), the Clerk of the County Council shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Greenville County, once a week for two successive weeks the following information:

- (a) the results of this action of the Greenville County Council; and
- (b) the fact that this Resolution does not authorize the issuance of additional bonds by the Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict; and
- (c) the fact that there will be no new Commission or changes made in the personnel of the present Commission of the Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict.

EXHIBIT A

Description of Metropolitan Expansion Area

Area North of 185 (Southern Connector)

All those contiguous pieces, parcels or tracts of land located in the southern portion of Greenville County that are contiguous to the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and located on the northern side of Interstate 185 (Southern Connector). Such parcels being bounded (i) on the west by the intersection of Interstate 185 (Southern Connector) and Reedy Fork Road, (ii) on the north by Reedy Fork Road, (iii) on the east by Fork Shoals Road, and (iv) on the south by Interstate 185 (Southern Connector).

Area South of 185 (Southern Connector)

All those contiguous pieces, parcels or tracts of land located in the southern portion of Greenville County that are located on the southern side of Interstate 185 (Southern Connector) that are not currently located within the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict, the City of Simpsonville or the City of Fountain Inn. Said parcels being bounded (i) on the west by the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and McMahan Mill Road, (ii) on the north by the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and Interstate 185 (Southern Connector), (iii) on the east by the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and the City of Simpsonville and (iv) on the South by the centerline of West Georgia Road.
