WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6-11-410, et seq., of the 1976 Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina, as amended (the Act), the governing bodies of the several counties of the State of South Carolina are authorized to enlarge, diminish or consolidate any existing special purpose districts located within such counties; and the Greenville County Council is the governing body of Greenville County, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict (“Metropolitan”) was created by Act No. 687 of the 1969 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, as amended by Act No. 1842 of the 1972 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, and as such is a special purpose district created prior to March 7, 1973 to which has been committed the function of acquiring, constructing, operating, maintaining, improving, and extending facilities for the orderly collecting of sewage within the boundaries of Metropolitan and the transmission of the same to the trunk and treatment facilities of Renewable Water Resources (“ReWa”) (formerly Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority, formerly Greenville County Sewer Authority) for treatment and disposal; and

WHEREAS, the real property described in Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B attached hereto is located in the southern portion of Greenville County and was formally within the boundaries of Metropolitan. However, the boundaries of Metropolitan were diminished by the Greenville County Council over twenty five years ago and such property is not located within any special purpose district or municipality empowered to accept and

maintain lateral and collector lines for the transmission of sewage and waste to the trunk and treatment facilities of REWA; and

WHEREAS, the County Council Members representing Districts 25 and 26 have recommended that Metropolitan seek to enlarge its boundaries to reinstate and include the properties described in Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated herein (the "Metropolitan Expansion Area");

WHEREAS, in connection with the anticipated planning and economic development of the southern portions of Greenville County and the above referenced recommendations, the Commissioners of Metropolitan have determined that it is necessary and desirable to expand the boundaries of Metropolitan to reinstate and include the Metropolitan Expansion Area;

WHEREAS, Metropolitan hereby petitions the Greenville County Council to expand the boundaries of Metropolitan to reinstate and include the Metropolitan Expansion Area in accordance with all of the terms and conditions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan has agreed to pay Greenville County for incurred advertising expenses due to public hearings and public notices required in such expansion procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict hereby formally petition the Greenville County Council to enlarge and reinstate the boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict as set forth in this Petition and in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

## **EXHIBIT A**

### Description of Metropolitan Expansion Area

#### **Area North of 185 (Southern Connector)**

All those contiguous pieces, parcels or tracts of land located in the southern portion of Greenville County that are contiguous to the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and located on the northern side of Interstate 185 (Southern Connector). Such parcels being bounded (i) on the west by the intersection of Interstate 185 (Southern Connector) and Reedy Fork Road, (ii) on the north by Reedy Fork Road, (iii) on the east by Fork Shoals Road, and (iv) on the south by Interstate 185 (Southern Connector).

#### **Area South of 185 (Southern Connector)**

All those contiguous pieces, parcels or tracts of land located in the southern portion of Greenville County that are located on the southern side of Interstate 185 (Southern Connector) that are not currently located within the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict, the City of Simpsonville or the City of Fountain Inn. Said parcels being bounded (i) on the west by the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and McMahan Mill Road, (ii) on the north by the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and Interstate 185 (Southern Connector), (iii) on the east by the current boundaries of Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and the City of Simpsonville and (iv) on the South by the centerline of West Georgia Road.
