

A RESOLUTION

TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED BY THE GREENVILLE COUNTY ART MUSEUM.

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Art Museum is a special purpose district, located wholly within the County of Greenville; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the Museum is authorized by law to annually levy, for operations and maintenance, ad valorem property tax millage, as allowed by S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A) and has requested a three-tenths (0.3) mill increase; and

WHEREAS, according to the provisions contained in S.C. Code §§ 6-11-271 and 6-11-275, as amended, special purpose districts that are totally located within a county, were in existence prior to March 7, 1973, and have the statutory authority to annually levy taxes for operations and maintenance are authorized to increase their respective millage limitations upon the written approval of the governing body of the county in which they are located.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Greenville County Council hereby approves an increase of two-tenths (0.2) of a mill which represents consumer price index and population growth under the three year lookback provision of S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A) and one-tenth (0.1) of a mill to establish a reserve account pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(D) resulting in levy of one and five-tenths (1.5) mills for operations and maintenance of the Greenville County Art Museum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect the millage rate authorized by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the millage authorized by this Resolution and effectuated pursuant to S.C. Code §§ 6-11-271 and 6-11-275, as amended.
