

A RESOLUTION

TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED BY THE SLATER-MARIETTA FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Slater-Marietta Fire District is a special purpose district located wholly within the County of Greenville; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Control for the Slater-Marietta Fire District is authorized to annually levy, for operations and maintenance, ad valorem property tax millage not exceeding ten (10.0) mills and has requested an increase to its present millage rate; and

WHEREAS, according to the provisions contained in S.C. Code §§ 6-11-271 and 6-11-275, as amended, special purpose districts totally located within a county, which were in existence prior to March 7, 1973, and which have the statutory authority to annually levy taxes for operations and maintenance are authorized to modify their respective millage limitations upon the written approval of the governing body of the county in which they are located; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Greenville County Council approves an increase of eleven (11.0) mills for the Slater-Marietta Fire District, consisting of one and eight-tenths (1.8) mills which represents the consumer price index and population growth lookback as allowed by S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A), and nine and two-tenths (9.2) mills for the maintenance of a reserve account as allowed under S.C. Code § 6-1-320(D) for a total millage of twenty-five (25.0) mills.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Tax Collector are hereby directed to levy and collect a total millage rates authorized by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the millage increase authorized by this Resolution is effectuated pursuant to S.C. Code §§ 6-11-271 and 6-11-275, as amended.
