

A RESOLUTION

TO ENLARGE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE GREATER GREENVILLE SANITATION DISTRICT TO INCLUDE THE WOODLAND POINTE SUBDIVISION, 120 PASCO COURT, 207 WOODBURY CIRCLE, AND 211 GROCE ROAD; AND PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC NOTICE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6-11-410, et seq., of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended (“S.C. Code Ann.”), the governing bodies of the several counties of the State are authorized to enlarge, diminish or consolidate any existing special purpose districts located within such counties; and the Greenville County Council is the governing body of Greenville County, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Greenville Sanitation District (“GGSD”) was created pursuant to Act No. 1543 of the 1968 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, and as such is a special purpose district created prior to March 7, 1973 to which has been committed the function of collecting refuse, garbage and trash within the district, and to engage in the operations of dumps or landfills for the orderly disposal of refuse, garbage and trash within Greenville County; and

WHEREAS, a petition has been submitted to Greenville County Council by the owners of the real property located in Greenville County to have said property annexed into and made a part of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District, a copy of maps showing the following parcels is attached hereto as *Exhibit A*:

- A. That certain real property located on Standing Springs Road near its intersection with Ashmore Bridge Road in Greenville, South Carolina, to be known as Woodland Pointe Subdivision and bearing TMS# 0413000100401; and
- B. That certain real property located at 120 Pasco Court, Piedmont, South Carolina bearing TMS# WG05040105200; and
- C. That certain real property located at 207 Woodbury Circle, Taylors, South Carolina bearing TMS# P016020124400; and
- D. That certain real property located at 211 Groce Road, Greenville, South Carolina bearing TMS# 0508010102204.

WHEREAS, Greater Greenville Sanitation District has consented to the annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville County Council finds that the above described properties are located wholly within the boundaries of Greenville County, South Carolina, but is not within any special purpose district or municipality which is empowered to collecting refuse, garbage and trash, that annexing such property into the Greater Greenville Sanitation District would extend the facilities for the orderly collecting refuse, garbage and trash within the boundaries of GGSD; and

WHEREAS, Greenville County Council finds that it is in the public interest that the

boundaries of said District be enlarged so as to include the properties described above and appearing on *Exhibit A*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Greenville County Council that the boundaries of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District are hereby enlarged to include the following properties:

- A. That certain real property located on Standing Springs Road near its intersection with Ashmore Bridge Road in Greenville, South Carolina, to be known as Woodland Pointe Subdivision and bearing TMS# 0413000100401; and
- B. That certain real property located at 120 Pasco Court, Piedmont, South Carolina bearing TMS# WG05040105200; and
- C. That certain real property located at 207 Woodbury Circle, Taylors, South Carolina bearing TMS# P016020124400; and
- D. That certain real property located at 211 Groce Road, Greenville, South Carolina bearing TMS# 0508010102204.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 6-11-470 (Supp. 2001), the Clerk of the County Council shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Greenville County, once a week for two successive weeks the following information:

- (a) the results of this action of the Greenville County Council;
- (b) the fact that this Resolution does not authorize the issuance of additional bonds by the Greater Greenville Sanitation District; and
- (c) the fact that there will be no new Commission or changes made in the personnel of the present Commission of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District.
