Item (3) **Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of PWI Committee on August 20, 2019.**

MOTION: By Mr. Tripp to approve the minutes of the August 20, 2019 Committee meeting as presented. The motion carried by voice vote with one absent (Fant).

Item (4) **Amendment to the Solid Waste Ordinance**

Paula Gucker, Assistant County Administrator introduced Marcia Papin, Solid Waste Manager who stated she brought before the Committee an amendment to the Solid Waste Management Plan which has not been updated since the mid 90's. She stated most of the updates are correcting the new technical names for what certain things are called within the Solid Waste Industry. Additionally, complying with State banned requirements. She explained some of the changes, one being fees have been removed due to that being done during the budget process. Ms. Papin discussed what residents are not charged for and noted they are charged for construction and demolition debris and oversized tree trimmings. She stated the most noted changes were from 3 cubic yards per visit per day to 3 cubic yards per day.

Ms. Seman asked about how much out of State or out of County waste is taken in.

Ms. Papin stated she took very little out of State waste. She stated there was a Memorandum of Understanding with Laurens County and they take all municipal solid waste from Laurens County and Pickens County.

After further discussion regarding fees, taking out of county waste and requests for clarification the following motion was made.

MOTION: By Mr. Ballard to hold the amended ordinance until the next meeting to allow the Committee time to study some of the details. The motion carried by voice vote with one absent (Fant).
