NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Greenville County Council during the live-streamed Regular Meeting on August 18, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. (or such time thereafter as other public hearings are concluded) for the purpose of receiving public comments in regards to the Clear Spring Fire and Rescue District operational millage levy for the Tax Year 2020-2021.

The Clear Spring Fire and Rescue District Board of Commissioners has requested that Greenville County Council approve an ad valorem property tax increase of three and four-tenths (3.4) mills, bringing the total millage for operations and maintenance of the Clear Spring Fire and Rescue District to twenty-seven and three-tenths (27.3) mills, which consists of operating millage allowable (CPI and population growth) for FY2020-2021 pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(a)(1) and operating millage allowed but not imposed for the three preceding property tax year pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(a)(2).
