

PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Greenville County Council during the live-streamed Regular Meeting on August 18, 2020, at 4:00 p.m. (or such time thereafter as other public hearings are concluded) for the purpose of considering a resolution to increase the statutory Ad Valorem millage rate established for the Greater Greenville Sanitation District as requested by the Greater Greenville Sanitation District Commission for the FY2021 Tax Year.

The Greater Greenville Sanitation District Commission, pursuant to the provisions of S.C. Code Ann. Sections 6-11-271 and 6-11-275, as amended, has requested that Greenville County Council approve an increase of five-tenths (0.5) mills for the Greater Greenville Sanitation District bringing their total operation and maintenance millage to fifteen and nine-tenths (15.9) mills, representing a consumer price index and population growth of 3.55% as allowed pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A).
