Total Grant Request: \$312,631
State Funds (90%): \$281,369
Greenville County Match (10%): \$31,262

Operational Impact
The County is applying for grant funds to incorporate an IBIS/NIBIN ballistic system for the Forensics lab. This system will allow investigators to associate crime scenes and evidence together and also assist with identification of individuals associated with the crimes. Grant funding will be used for equipment acquisition, installation costs, and one FTE position to operate the system.

Under the advice of the Assistant US Attorney for the District of South Carolina (Justin W. Holloway), this grant, as well as the Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant, has been submitted for the same project in the hopes that one of the NIBIN grants would be approved.
