Item Title: Boiling Springs Fire District

Action Taken by Committee previously: The Finance Committee last approved a millage increase for the Boiling Springs Fire District for Fiscal Year 2019 – Resolution 1655. The Committee approved its continuation for Fiscal Year 2020.

Motion Requested Today: Boiling Springs Fire District requests adoption of a Resolution approving a millage increase in the District's tax rate of two (2.0) mills from 27.4 mills to 29.4 mills for operation and maintenance. The requested rate increase represents CPI and population growth and a "lookback" as allowed per Section 6-1-320 (A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws for Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021.

Staff Recommendation: N/A

Impact of Action: A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$180,000 would pay an additional \$14.40 annually due to this millage increase for operations.
