**Item (3) Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of PWI Committee on January 7, 2020.**

**Item (4) SCDOT/Greenville County Road Swap**

Hesha Gamble, County Engineer addressed the Committee members with a request of approval for a mass acceptance and abandonment list of roads within Greenville County. She noted there has been one swap of roads and this was round two. The members were provided a list of roads with their agenda packets. Ms. Gamble requested approval and to forward the request to full Council.

**MOTION:** By Mr. Tripp to approve and forward to full Council the SCDOT/Greenville County Road Swap/Road Transfer list. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

Ms. Gucker stated the road swap was something the County had been trying to do for a number of years. The first swap was a success and the SCDOT Commission is using Greenville County as a model across the state for how to deal better with roads and put the correct roads in the correct hands.

**Item (5) Waterline Grant Application – 108 Roberts Circle, Greer, SC**

Paula Gucker, Assistant County Administrator addressed the Committee members with a waterline grant application for 108 Roberts Circle. She state the applicant's portion is \$2,928.23, which the county has received. The balance in the account is \$67,534.75.

**MOTION:** By Mr. Tripp to approve and forward to full Council the Waterline Grant Application for 108 Roberts Circle. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.
