

Recreational Trails Program (RTP)

Pavilion Recreation Complex Walking Trail

The South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism (SCPRT) administers the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) under the approval of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). This federally funded program receives its funding from a portion of federal gas taxes paid on fuel used in non-highway recreational vehicles.

Funding provided by this competitive program is on a cost-reimbursement basis. Project sponsors must initiate their approved projects with their own funds and be reimbursed up to 80 percent of allowable costs after submitting documentation of expenses. Individual trail grants can range from a minimum of \$10,000 (\$12,500 would be the total project cost) to \$100,000 maximum (\$125,000—total project cost).

The proposed project will introduce a paved walking path around athletic fields at the park. The department of Parks, Recreation, & Tourism has the local funds available in a capital account allocated for the Pavilion Recreation Complex approved in the FY 20/21 budget.
