The Greenville County Redevelopment Authority (GCRA) Board and Staff is submitting the enclosed Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Annual Action Plan (AAP) for review and approval by County Council Finance Committee and County Council. The FY 2021 AAP is consistent with the goals and strategies identified in the County's Five- Year Consolidated Strategic Plan (2020 -2024) in addressing Housing, Homelessness and Community Development challenges throughout the unincorporated areas of Greenville County and the five municipalities of Fountain, Greer, Mauldin, Simpsonville, and Travelers Rest.

Additionally included, is the continuation of implementation of the supplemental funding in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) COVID-19 funds from HUD, in accordance with the Coronavirus Aid and Economic Security Act (CARES-Act) to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19).

The Greenville County Redevelopment Authority's staff visited and held public hearings in the five municipalities and in the unincorporated communities of the Greenville County. Comments and suggestions regarding the FY 2021 Annual Action Plan are included in the submission and are instrumental in developing strategies for the plan.

All documents require review and approval by Council for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for approval.
