A RESOLUTION

TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ENLARGING THE GREATER GREENVILLE SANITATION DISTRICT TO INCLUDE 11 GREENWOOD AVENUE AND 1240 ALTAMONT ROAD.

WHEREAS, petitions have been submitted to Greenville County Council by the owners the properties located at 11 Greenwood Avenue (TMS# 0278000100202 & 0278000100200) and 1240 Altamont Road (TMS# 0462000100500) shown on *Exhibit A* (collectively the "*Properties*"), to have the Properties annexed into and made a part of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing be held for the purpose of determining whether the boundaries of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District shall be enlarged to include the Properties.
