

PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Greenville County Council during the live streamed meeting in the Council Chambers at 301 University Ridge, Greenville, on Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., (or as soon thereafter as other hearings are concluded), for the purpose of determining whether the boundaries of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District should be enlarged to include those certain properties located at 11 Greenwood Avenue and 1240 Altamont Road, Greenville, for the purpose of collecting and disposing of refuse, garbage and trash within Greenville County.

The new boundary lines to result for the Greater Greenville Sanitation District would include the following Tax Map Numbers (TMS#): 11 Greenwood Avenue (0278000100202 & 0278000100200) and 1240 Altamont Road (0462000100500). A map of the new boundaries and legal descriptions are available in the County Council Office.

The reason for the proposed enlargement is to provide for the orderly collection and disposal of refuse. No additional bonds will be issued by the district, nor will there be any change in the commission or in the personnel of the present commission of the Greater Greenville Sanitation District.

Anyone wishing to speak during this public hearing will need to register on-site during the 30 minutes prior to the start of the meeting. Any person interested in this matter may appear and be heard.
