

A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE THE TERMS OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MAULDIN AND OTHER PARTIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PROJECT KNOWN AS PROJECT KICK.

WHEREAS, Greenville County enacted Ordinance 4928 on August 15, 2017, placing property in the City of Mauldin into the Anderson-Greenville Joint County Industrial and Business Park; and

WHEREAS, Greenville County entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Mauldin for the distribution of certain Park revenues to the City for the acquisition of public improvements for the benefit of economic development; and

WHEREAS, the Mauldin City Council held a meeting on January 10, 2022 to discuss an economic development matter currently known as Project Kick; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mauldin expressed an interest in partnering with the County of Greenville and other parties with regards to the development of Project Kick.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. The County Administrator is hereby given authority to negotiate and develop an agreement with the City of Mauldin and other parties relating to an economic development project currently known as Project Kick.

Section 2. The County Administrator will bring the terms of such agreement to County Council for approval.
