

A RESOLUTION

TO COMMIT COUNTY FUNDS TO MATCH A LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR TO GREENVILLE COUNTY PARKS, RECREATION & TOURISM, A DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, The Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Program provides matching grants to states and local governments for the acquisition and development of public outdoor recreation areas and facilities; and

WHEREAS, Greenville County Parks, Recreation & Tourism (Greenville County Rec), a department of the County of Greenville, South Carolina is applying for such a grant to make improvements to the Pavilion Recreation Complex; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the grant require the recipient to commit matching funds; and

WHEREAS, Greenville County Rec has adequate funds designated to these improvements and desires to commit those funds to match LWCF funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL that Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000) be committed to match Three Hundred Thousand dollars (\$300,000) in grant funds from LWCF to Greenville County Rec for the purpose of making improvements to the Pavilion Recreation Complex.
