Search and Rescue Equipment Request

Highest Priority need:

Guardian Angel Infrared Hybrid Blue/Blue Wearable Safety Light: Many of our call outs are at night and in urban environments that take us around many busy roadways. Being seen by motorist is a constant concern and we have had a few close calls as it is hard for people to see us crossing the road at night, even with other patrol vehicles around or trying to follow us. This light is an individual unit that can be attached to our vest, backpacks, or helmets, and would allow us to have a personal "light bar" that we can turn on in these situations. It would offer enhanced safety to both Deputies and the traveling motorist. In rural/mountain environments this would also allow an infrared light source for our drones and helicopter to see us from the sky and give us a light for other Deputies to help see or find their partners in the dark. Cost is \$135 per unit. We would need 18 units to outfit everyone on the team. Total Cost: \$2,430
