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**Item Title:** **Boiling Springs Fire District Millage Continuation of and Issuance of General Obligation Debt**

**Action Taken by Committee previously:** The Finance Committee approved the continuation of the operating millage for Fiscal Year 2021 which represented no increase over the previous year's millage.

**Motion Requested Today:** Boiling Springs Fire District requests adoption of a Resolution approving the continuation of the present millage rate of 27.5 mills for operations and maintenance, and for the approval of a resolution calling for a public hearing and authorizing the District to issue general obligation bonds.
