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**Item Title:** Canebrake Fire District Millage Request

**Action Taken by Committee previously:** The Finance Committee approved an increase in the ad valorem property tax levy for Canebrake Fire operations in 2017 – Ordinance 4921.

**Motion Requested Today:** Canebrake Fire District is requesting a millage increase of five and seven-tenths (5.7) mills for operations. This request consists of operating millage allowable (CPI and population growth) for FY2022-2023 pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A)(1) and operating millage allowed but not imposed for the three preceding property tax years pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A)(2).

**Staff Recommendation:** N/A

**Impact of Action:** A resident owning a house with a taxable market value of \$200,000 would pay an additional \$45.60 annually in Fire District taxes
