Action Taken by Committee previously:		The Finance Committee approved an increase in the ad valorem property tax levy for Canebrake Fire operations in 2017 – Ordinance 4921.

This request consists of operating millage allowable (CPI and population growth) for FY2022-2023 pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A)(1) and operating millage allowed but not imposed for the three preceding property tax years pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(A)(2).
