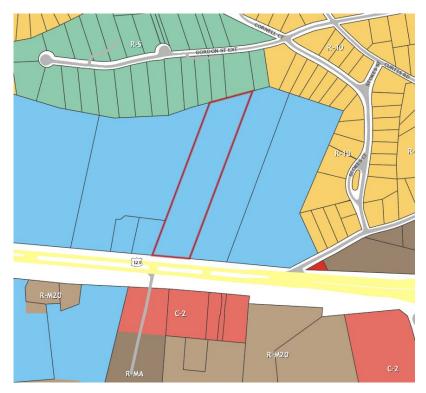

RECOMMENDATION: Based on these reasons, staff recommends denial of the requested

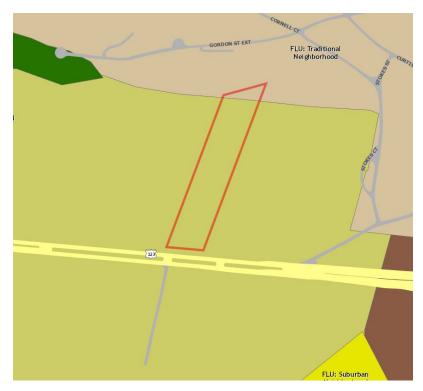

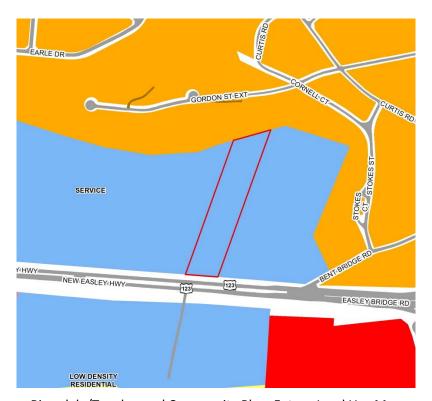
