## Amendment 5: Amend Committee section to update listing, membership, and Chairman role

## SECTION V. COMMITTEES

## (C) Appointment to Standing Committees

(1) Not later than the second regular Council meeting in January following each General Election, the Chairman of Council shall appoint <u>up to</u> five (5) Council members to: the Committee on Planning and Development; the Committee on <u>Roads Infrastructure and Public Works</u>; the Committee on Public Safety and Human Services; <u>the Committee on Communications and Governmental Affairs</u>; <u>and up six (6) members</u> to the Committee on Finance <u>should the Chairman of Council elect to serve as a voting member. The Chairman of Council may serve as an *ex-officio*, <u>non-voting member on the above listed committees</u>. The Chairman of Council shall appoint the Chairman for each Committee. After the appointment, a committee chairman can only be removed as Chair and/or reassigned to another committee by the Chairman of Council with the approval of six (6) additional Council members. The Chairman of each Committee shall appoint the Vice-Chairman for his or her respective Committee.</u>
