Amendment 6: Amend Zoning Motion from P&D Committee and clarify Committee Reports

SECTION V. COMMITTEES

(F) <u>Committee Reports and Recommendations</u>

- (2) All zoning matters properly referred to the Planning and Development Committee must be reported to full Council in a timely manner with a recommendation for approval, denial, approval as modified, or "no recommendation." <u>At Council</u> <u>meetings, the Planning and Development Committee will present zoning dockets</u> with the Committee's recommendation as the initial motion for consideration.
- (3) Matters before committees shall be reported to full Council only if approved, approved as modified, or with "no recommendation". When the question before a committee is for approval or approval as modified, a tie vote fails and the matter (other than a zoning matter) is defeated. The Chairman of a standing committee shall can report upon the activity of the committee at each regular County Council meeting, and the agenda of every regular meeting shall provide a time for committee chairman to make these reports as needed.
