I taught high school/college English for forty years, so I know the importance of literacy and reading for everyone and how such skills impact the health of the community at large. I also worked in business for seven years, so I have an understanding of what the needs are of industries. I worked for the publisher McGraw-Hill for one year as a salesman and five years as an editor. My job duties were varied; for example, I tested microcomputer software for several years in the mid-1980s and wrote reports for businesses on the results of those tests. I then worked about a year as an assistant director at an educational research center at Temple University in Philadelphia. I then taught English for over thirty years at Greenville Technical College, even serving as department head for sixteen years. Thus, I have great experience in the areas that directly impact libraries and those they serve.

#### My community topics of concern that relate to the Library Board of Trustees Commission:

My primary concern is dealing with a problem that affects libraries not only in Greenville County but also throughout South Carolina and the country as a whole: small, vocal groups that want to restrict what books and information people have access to at their local library. Too often these small groups have worked to limit access to books and materials that in their narrow view of the world are problematic or offensive. These people need to be heard and listened to, but they should not be allowed to dictate to the majority simply because certain books and materials do not align with their view of what is appropriate.

Beyond that, I plan to work hard to ensure that library funds are spent carefully to benefit the majority of the people in Greenville County.
