

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE GREENVILLE COUNTY HISTORIC AND NATURAL RESOURCES TRUST (HNRT) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR A PROJECT KNOWN TO THE COUNTY AT THIS TIME AS HNRT PROJECT CAMPFIRE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by Greenville County Council:

Section 1. Findings. County Council has established the Greenville County Historic and Natural Resources Trust (“Trust” or “HNRT”) by adoption of Ordinance No. 5247, as amended, (“Ordinance”) to protect lands with significant natural, cultural or historic resources in Greenville County. The Trust, by and through its governing board (“Board”), is authorized to make grants in support of projects that meet the conservation and financial criteria set forth in the Ordinance and achieve the most meaningful impact for Greenville County. Projects receiving HNRT funding in excess of \$200,000 require the recommendation of the Board and approval of County Council.

Section 2. Board Recommendation of Funding. The Board has recommended approval of a grant to _____ (“Grantee”) in the amount of \$350,000.00 for a project known to the County at this time as HNRT Project Campfire to place a conservation easement on the land described in Exhibit A (“Property”) for the purpose of permanently conserving the Property.

Section 3. Council Authorization of Funding. County Council hereby approves and authorizes the Trust to fund HNRT Project Campfire as set forth herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
