Re: No More Homeless Pets Spay-Neuter Grant

Greenville County Animal Care was awarded a \$2,000 grant from the South Carolina No More Homeless Pets (NMHP) license plate special fund to supports local animal spaying and neutering programs. The grant will be used to continue providing no-cost spay/neuter surgeries to citizens participating in Greenville County's community cat TNR (trap-neuter-return) program.

This is a continuing grant opportunity, meaning that once a grant is fulfilled, Animal Care can apply and receive additional funds (in \$2,000 increments) multiple times throughout the fiscal year provides funds remain available in the NMHP license plate special fund.

This grant funding request does not require a matching grant from the County.
