Supply justification The Greenville County Coroner's Office is located in South Carolina and is one of the busiest Coroner's Office in the state. An infrastructure upgrade of high quality digital cameras will allow the department to document scenes at a higher quality and continue to maintain compliance with IACME accreditation. The upgrade in cameras will allow the department to upgrade it's reporting of overdose deaths which are the leading cause of deaths in the county outside of natural occurrences. The department does actively report out on SUDORS and participates with other agencies in the overdose crisis.

The department currently has all digital cameras however; the cameras are not uniform and most have become unserviceable. The office is currently staffed with a total of 16 Deputy Coroners. If the office was granted the \$20,000 for an infrastructure upgrade of high quality digital cameras this would outfit each Deputy Coroner with an updated camera and allow for spares in the event of repair if needed.
