Item Title: Greenville County General Obligation Bond Issuance

Action Taken by Committee previously: County Council approved the issuance of General Obligation bonds for the Simpsonville Magistrate Office in the fiscal year 2022-2023 biennium budget. County Council created the River Falls Fire District in 1984 to provide fire protection in the unincorporated area of the County (Ord. No. 1333) and later established the District as an Administrative Division of the County on October 17, 2017 (Ord. 4944).

Motion Requested Today: Approval of the ordinances consenting to the issuance of General Obligation bonds to provide funding for (1) the construction and equipping of the Simpsonville Magistrate Office; and (2) acquisition of a new fire truck and related equipment for the River Falls Fire District.

Staff Recommendation: Approval of the ordinances

Impact of Action: The Ordinances approve the issuance of bonds for the construction of the Simpsonville Magistrate Office and the acquisition of a new fire truck for the River Falls Fire District.

Funding Amount/Source: Not exceeding \$6 million SeriesA and \$800,000 SeriesB General Obligation Bonds
