## Background Information

- 1. South Carolina Code of Laws [Section 12-43-220(d)(3)] does not allow the special assessment to transfer. New owners must make written application on or before the first penalty date for taxes due for the first tax year in which the special assessment is claimed.
- 2. South Carolina Code of Laws [Section 12-43-220(d)(3)] allows the governing body to extend the time for filing if an individual can satisfactorily show reasonable cause for not filing on or before the first penalty date.
